Useful Guidelines

DAILY FEE: is a single-entry fee valid for 24 hours of continuous uninterrupted stay inside a KWS National Park / Reserve / Sanctuary.

EAST AFRICAN CITIZEN: a native of East Africa Countries (Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, Somalia, South Sudan and Democratic Republic of Congo) with valid identification documents or passport.

KENYAN RESIDENT: refers to persons of other nationalities residing in Kenya with valid documentation from the Kenyan Government.

STUDENT: is herein defined as an individual from a recognized secondary, government or private college / university aged up to 23 years old and visiting the Parks for purposes of learning about conservation through a documented and organized arrangement with that institution. It excludes students on personally arranged holidays. KWS will require a minimum of two (2) weeks' notice in order to issue written authorization for student rates.

CHILDREN: refers to persons from 3 years but below 18 years.

MOUNT KENYA PACKAGES: these do not include camping fees. Camping fees are paid separately.

CORPORATE PASS: may be issued to eligible utility providers having installations within KWS managed Parks / Reserves.

KWS SELF_CATERING ACCOMMODATION:

KWS offers a wide range of affordable self-catering accommodation in our National Parks and Reserves.

• Proof of identity is required before entry into any KWS managed Park / Reserve / Sanctuary
